

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COCHRANE

BY-LAW NUMBER 126-2001

BEING A BY-LAW REGULATING BICYCLES IN THE TOWN OF COCHRANE

WHEREAS authority is granted under the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990.c.M45, Section 207, paragraph 42, to prohibit certain vehicles and conveyances including bicycles, being upon, or being used, drawn, hauled or propelled along or upon any sidewalk, pathway or footpath, used buy or set apart for the use of pedestrian an in certain areas;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cochrane to enact a By-Law regulating bicycles in the Town of Cochrane and for prohibiting their use in areas used by pedestrians in the Town of Cochrane;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cochrane enacts as follows:

Definitions

1. In this By-Law:
 - (a) **“Rural Area”** means that portion of the Town of Cochrane which was previously within the territorial area of the Corporation of the Township of Glackmeyer and geographic Township of Lamarche prior to amalgamation with the Town of Cochrane;
 - (b) **“Town of Cochrane”** means both the rural and urban areas of the Town of Cochrane, including the Urban Area and the Rural Area comprises of those areas in the Township of Glackmeyer and Lamarche;
 - (c) **“Urban Area”** means that portion of the Town of Cochrane which was previously within the territorial area of the Corporation of the Town of Cochrane prior to the amalgamation with the Corporation of the Township of Glackmeyer and the Township of Lamarche.

Prohibited Areas

2. No person shall permit or cause a bicycle to be upon, or be used, drawn, hauled or propelled along or upon, any sidewalk, pathway or foot path, used by or set apart for the use of pedestrians and forming part of any highway or bridge, boulevard or other means or public transportation, or being in or upon any highway, boulevard, park, park-lot, garden or other place set apart for ornament, decorative and aesthetic purposes or for public recreation.

Penalty

3. Every person who contravenes the provision of this By-Law shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than **FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS** as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter P.33, as amended.

Repeal

4. This By-Law shall repeal By-Law Number 2147-85, as amended, of the former Corporation of the Town of Cochrane.

Effect

5. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
