  - a. *Zone F includes: Cochrane Town, Cochrane/Iroquois Falls, Black River Matheson Locality –Mortimer, Pyne, St. John, Hanna, Stimson, Fox, Brower, Fournier, Ottawa, Kennedy, Clute, Calder, Blount and Leitch Townships, Smooth Rock Falls Town, Fauquier-Strickland, Moonbeam, Kapuskasing, Smooth Rock Falls & District Locality-Haggart and Nansen Townships*
- 2. French Public – Conseil Scolaire Public du Nord-East de l'Ontario – (1) One Position for School Board Trustee for Zone F**
  - a. *Zone F includes: Cochrane, Cochrane Iroquois Falls/BR-Matheson Locality*
- 3. French Separate – Conseil Scolaire Catholiques des Grand Rivieres – (1) One Position for School Board Trustee for Zone E**
  - a. *Zone E includes: Black River-Matheson, Iroquois Falls, Cochrane, Cochrane/Iroquois Falls/Black River-Matheson Locality Education (#5640) Moosonee*

may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, certified cheque, money order or electronic payment if specified by the Clerk.

A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent during regular business hours between May 1, 2026, and August 20, 2026, and between 9 am and 2 pm on August 21, 2026 (Nomination Day).

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only on Wednesday, August 26, 2026, between the hours of 9 am and 2 pm and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, as per *section 40 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, notice of election information will be provided.
